TENNESSEE STATE FORESTS EARN SFI FOREST MANAGEMENT STANDARD CERTIFICATION

All of Tennessee's 15 state forests, covering 168,359 acres/68,132 hectares, are now certified to the Sustainable Forestry Initiative Forest Management Standard.

A group of 139 printers in major cities and markets in the U.S. has recently certified to the SFI Chain-of-Custody Standard, the largest SFI group certification of any industry to the standard.
