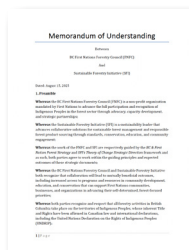


### TRIBAL FORESTRY & WILDLAND FIRE VOICES: A CAREER GUIDE
