## **Wisconsin School Forest History**

The early 1900's

- Wisconsin was experiencing the cut-over. Farming was not successful on these lands.
- Visionaries in forestry, conservation, and education set the stage for today's program
  - H. L. Russell UWMadison, Dean of CALS 1907 – 1930
  - Wakelin "Ranger Mac" McNeel
  - Fred Trenk First School Forest Administrator
  - Continued by Ted Peterson and Bill Sylvester


## Wisconsin School Forest Registrations by Decade
































































### Laona School Forest – recognized as first in the Nation



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
## The WI School Forest Program



#### A school forest is...

- land registered through state Community Forest Program *Wisconsin State Statute 28.20 Community forests.*
- owned or *controlled* by a school and used for environmental education and natural resource management

#### What LEAF Offers


- Professional Development for Educators
